- 2) Resolution having the Hudson County Mutli-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan be adopted by the Town of Secaucus
- 3) Resolution to bill for Property Tax Deduction(s) disallowed for 2014 to nine (9) separate homeowners
