Last Call for Substantial Damage Training

Local floodplain management regulations for communities that participate in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) contain minimum requirements that apply, not only to new structures, but also to existing structures determined to be “Substantially Improved” (SI) or “Substantially Damaged” (SD).



FEMA is hosting a free 2-part webinar series for NJ community officials about SI/SD requirements and the Substantial Damage Estimator (SDE).

Enforcing these requirements is a crucial part of a community’s floodplain management responsibilities, ensuring that older buildings are brought up to current standards that **keep people and property safe**. The SDE tool helps floodplain administrators and other community officials to develop reasonable estimates of structure values and damages in accordance with FEMA requirements. The tool also provides a consistent method for damage assessment as well as reports that can be shared with property owners and the public to justify the results.
