Health Department Update- June 2020

1. COVID-19

The Health Department, along with Town Administration, continues to follow proper protocols and regulations issued by County, State, and/or Federal officials during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Health Department office and Town Administration, under guidance of our Health Officer and State and Federal directives, continue to come up with necessary measures in response to COVID-19. As the situations are rapidly evolving, procedures and requirements continue to change at the Local, State, and/or Federal level to meet the needs and safety of the Secaucus community. The Health Department is also assisting in response to COVID-19 by conducting contact tracing investigations.

Recently, Governor Murphy made announcements for re-opening the State in its second stage. Effective June 15, 2020, retail food establishments will be permitted to offer outdoor dining while salons and outdoor pools are permitted to open on June 22, 2020, provided that the businesses adhere to the provisions under the Governor's Orders as well as State and Local Town requirements.
