ORDINANCE NO. 2019-38

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 127 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" DESIGNATING A PORTION OF HUMBOLDT STREET AS A ONE WAY ROADWAY

WHEREAS, Chapter 127 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus addresses various topics concerning vehicles and traffic in the Town in the interest of safety, including but not limited to the designation of streets as one-way; and

WHEREAS, the Secaucus Police Department Traffic Division, in conjunction with the Town Engineering Department, has reviewed traffic patterns, parking availability, speed and other data and obtained resident input regarding a portion of Humboldt Street situated between Centre Avenue and Raydol Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Secaucus Police Department Traffic Division, in conjunction with the Town Engineering Department, has recommended a roadway re-design which includes making Humboldt Street between Centre Avenue and Raydol Avenue a one-way street for uniformity of the direction of traffic on the entirety of this portion of the roadway, to calm the traffic flow and to allow for safer entry and exit of the roadway in this area; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council accept the Departments' recommendation in the interest of motorist and pedestrian safety and believe that an update to Chapter 127 is needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 127 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic," §127-29 "Schedule VII: One-Way Streets" of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended as follows: (deletions are indicated by erossouts; additions are indicated in **bold**):

§ 127-29. Schedule VII: One-Way Streets.

In accordance with the provisions of § 127-13, the following described streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as one-way streets in the direction indicated:

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-39

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 127A OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS ENTITLED "RESIDENTIAL PARKING" SPECIFYING TWO HOUR NON-RESIDENT PARKING AREA ON ENTIRE LENGTH OF HUMBOLDT STREET

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize that the safe parking of vehicles for all residents, visitors and motorists is of utmost concern; and

WHEREAS, the Town has a residential parking program under §127A-1 et seq. that was developed to alleviate unfavorable parking conditions and address conditions created on residential streets, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined based on resident needs and review by the Secaucus Police Traffic Division that the time limit for motor vehicles that do not display a Resident Parking Sticker or Parking Placard should be reduced to two hours on the entire length of Humboldt Street due to its close proximity to the plaza business district as part of the re-design of the roadway between Centre Avenue and Raydol Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 127A entitled "Residential Parking," §127A-6(A)(1) "Time limits nonresidents authorized to park in residential parking zones" of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows: (additions are indicated in **bold**, deletions are indicated by erossouts):

Α. ...

(1) No person shall park in any of the following locations, designated as "Parking for Residents Only," for longer than the specified time indicated below, except those whose motor vehicles display a Resident Parking Sticker or Parking Placard pursuant to this chapter, or are otherwise exempt from such parking restriction pursuant to this chapter:

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 102 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS ENTITLED "POCKET SCOOTERS"

WHEREAS, the Town had previously adopted Chapter 102 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus on October 26, 2004, placing restrictions on the utilization of pocket scooters, which were defined powered-driven devices upon which the operator sits and which have a capability of being propelled at speeds up to twenty-five (25) miles per hour, and which were unregulated by the State of New Jersey at that time; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that Chapter 102 should be repealed as "pocket scooters" are covered by state statutes, including <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 39:1-1 and <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 39:4-14.16, and Chapter 54 of the Code, which reflects the current laws and regulations in the State of New Jersey for E-scooters and E-bicycles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. Chapter 102 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus entitled "Pocket Scooters" adopted on October 26, 2004 under Ordinance Number 2004-26 be repealed in its entirety. Relevant provisions are contained in Chapter 54 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus.
- 2. This repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed.
- 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- 4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
- 5. This shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

1. Chapter 127 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic," §127-23" "Schedule I: No Parking" of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows: (additions are indicated in **bold**, deletions are indicated by strikethroughs):

§ 127-23. Schedule I: No Parking.

WHEREAS, EPT Meadowlands LP, the owner of real property located at 455 Plaza Drive, otherwise designated as Lot 6.04 in Block 227 on the official tax maps of the Town of Secaucus, has taken an appeal to the Tax Court of the State of New Jersey from the Assessed Value of said property for the Tax Years 2010, 2011, 2016 and 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed to a reduction in the real property's Assessed Values as follows:

WHEREAS, the Complaint filed for 2016 shall be withdrawn along with the Town's withdrawal of its Counterclaim; and

WHEREAS, by further agreement of the Taxpayer the Freeze Act shall not apply to the 2012 and 2013 Tax Years, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the Assessed Value for the 2020 Tax Year shall be \$19,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the Taxpayer has further agreed to waive statutory pre-judgment interest on the tax refund; and

WHEREAS, the Town Tax Assessor has agreed to the reduction in Assessed Value on the real property for the subject Tax Years in accordance with the settlement; and,

WHEREAS, the agreed upon reductions in Assessed Values has resulted in a total tax recapture by the Taxpayer for the property of \$200,265.50; and
