AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 127-58B OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS ENTITLED "DESIGNATION OF LOCATIONS AT OR NEAR PRIVATE RESIDENCES"

SECTION 1

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus that Section 127-58B - "Designation of Locations at or Near Private Residences" shall be amended by adding the following locations:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
Ninth Street	East	On the east side of Ninth Street, beginning at a point 246 feet south of the southeast corner of Centre Avenue and Ninth Street continuing south for a distance of 20 feet in front of 728 Ninth Street
Seventh Street	West	On the west side of Seventh Street, beginning at a point 113 feet south of the northwest corner of Flanagan Way and Seventh Street continuing south for a distance of 20 feet in front of 853 Seventh Street

That the parking space designated for 728 Ninth Street adopted by Ordinance is to be personalized for Placard Number P2725045.

That the parking space designated for 853 Seventh Street adopted by Ordinance is to be personalized for Placard Number P2738942.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus that Section 127-58B - "Designation of Locations at or Near Private Residences" shall be amended by deleting the following locations:

Golden Avenue	West	On the west side of Golden Avenue directly in front of 737 Golden Avenue
Hudson Avenue	West	Starting at the northwest corner of Front Street going north 201 feet to starting point and then 22 feet north to end of spot, which would be 223 feet from corner of Front. This would put the spot right in front of house
Humboldt Street	West	On the west side of Humboldt Street, beginning at a point 158 feet south of the southwest corner of Centre Avenue and Humboldt Street continuing south for a distance of 18 feet in front of 733 Humboldt Street
Julianne Terrace	South	On the south side of Julianne Terrace, beginning at a point 600 feet west of the southwest corner of Schopmann Drive and Julianne Terrace continuing west for a distance of 18 feet in front of 299 Julianne Terrace

Julianne Terrace	North	On the north side of Julianne Terrace, beginning at a point 740 feet west of the northwest corner of Julianne Terrace and Schopmann Drive continuing west for a distance of 22 feet directly in front of 304 Julianne Terrace
Paterson Plank Road	West	On the west side of Reidel Court, beginning at a point 32 feet south of the southeast corner of Paterson Plank Road and Reidel Court continuing south for a distance of 20 feet on the side of 1587 Paterson Plank Road
Second Street	East	On the east side of Second Street, beginning at a point 107 feet north of the northeast corner of Centre Avenue and Second Street continuing north for a distance of 18 feet in front of 758 Second Street
Second Avenue	North	On the north side of Second Avenue, beginning at a point 43 feet west of the northwest corner of Second Avenue and Cedar Avenue continuing west for a distance of 18 feet in front of 70 Second Avenue

SECTION 2

SEVERABILITY

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the provisions of this ordinance are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words, or parts of the regulation or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and if such persons or circumstances, to which the ordinance or part thereof is held inapplicable, had been specifically exempted therefrom.

SECTION 3

REPEALER

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4

EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-5

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 117 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF
SECAUCUS ENTITLED "STREET AND ROAD OPENINGS" ADDRESSING THE
STRIP BETWEEN THE CURB AND SIDEWALK**

WHEREAS, the Town enacted §117-1 *et seq.* to address opening, excavation or blockage of any roadway within its jurisdiction through a permit process to ensure that roadways are maintained in a safe and proper manner; and

WHEREAS, this Chapter specifies how maintenance and repair of street openings shall be done; and

WHEREAS, upon the review of the Town's Engineering Department, it is recommended that the strip between the curb and the sidewalk be required to be grass, where feasible, in the interest of promoting proper drainage and maintaining suitable material coverage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 117 entitled "Street and Road Openings, "§117-1. Definitions." of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows: (additions are indicated in **bold**):

§ 117-1 Definitions.

As used in this chapter the following words or phrases shall have the meanings indicated herein:

GRASS STRIP

The landscaped area between the curb and the sidewalk.

2. Chapter 117 entitled "Street and Road Openings, "§117-8. Maintenance and final repair of openings." of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows: (additions are indicated in **bold**):

§ 117-8 Maintenance and final repair of openings.

Unless otherwise directed by the Town Engineer or Construction Official, upon completion of the opening and backfill as specified in § 117-7, the following specifications shall govern the maintenance and repair of street openings by the permittee.

J.

Where deemed feasible by the Town Engineer, Zoning Official or Construction Official, a grass strip shall be required. No other material shall be installed in the grass strip besides topsoil, seeding, grass/sod and street trees.

3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED, that the remainder of this Chapter 117 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus shall remain in full force and effect.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-6

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 135 "ZONING" OF THE CODE OF
THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS TO UPDATE THE LANDSCAPING PROVISION**

WHEREAS, the Town of Secaucus has established a Zoning Ordinance pursuant to the Municipal Land Use Law designed to regulate buildings and uses as to their extent and impact upon the landscape; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that changes, recommended by the Zoning Official, are needed to update the landscaping provision in Chapter 135 to specify suitable materials for the strip between the curb and sidewalk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council for the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The following sections and provisions of Chapter 135 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus, "Zoning" be, and are hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows: (deletions are indicated by ~~crossouts~~; additions are indicated in **bold**):



§135-9.2 Landscaping.

A.

General provisions. The following general provisions shall apply to the installation and design of landscapes:

...

(3)

For any residential dwelling, there shall be a minimum of 30% of landscaped surface in the front yard. For purposes of calculation of this percentage, the strip between the sidewalk and the curb shall be included. **No other material shall be installed in this strip besides topsoil, seeding, grass/sod and street trees, unless deemed not feasible.** The required percentage of landscaped surface shall include at least six (6) shrubs from the approved species list and one (1) tree from the approved species list, with said tree either on the property or along the street line. Other trees, shrubs, ground cover, perennials and annuals may be used to meet any remaining required percentage of landscaped surface. The approved species list shall be kept on file with the Town Clerk and the Construction Department.

...

2. This Ordinance shall be subject to review and recommendation by the Town Planning Board in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26.
3. The County Planning Board shall be provided notice of this proposed ordinance in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:27-6.10.
4. There are no other changes to this Chapter of the Code of the Town of Secaucus.
5. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
6. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED, that the remainder of this Chapter and the Code of the Town of Secaucus shall remain in full force and effect.
