WHEREAS, the Town has reviewed and negotiated a Communications Site License Agreement with the Hudson County Schools of Technology for a position on the communications tower for municipal communications equipment and ancillary improvements located at Block 5, Lot 2.03, known as 1 High Tech Way, Secaucus, New Jersey.

COMMUNICATIONS SITE LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE HUDSON COUNTY SCHOOLS OF TECHNOLOGY AND THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS

This Lease Agreement made this _____ day of February 2022, by the Town of Secaucus, New Jersey, a New Jersey municipality, with principal offices located at 1203 Paterson Plank Road, Secaucus, New Jersey 07094 ("Town" or "Secaucus"), and the Hudson County Schools of Technology, a body politic, with principal offices located at 1 High Tech Way, Secaucus, New Jersey 07094 ("HCST").

WHEREAS, HCST is the Lessor in possession of the property known and designated as Block 5 Lot 2.03 in the Town of Secaucus, and parties hereto agree that all terms and conditions referenced in any plans or construction documents are fully incorporated by reference herein.

WHEREAS, Secaucus desires to lease a portion of the Premises from HCST for access to HCST's existing tower for placement of Secaucus' municipal communications antennas, to locate communications equipment in HCST's shelter, to place an emergency power generator for its use, and for appurtenant improvements.

WHEREAS, HCST hereby leases to Lessee and Lessee hereby leases from HCST that portion of the Premises, more particularly described as 200 square feet of ground space and sufficient space on the Tower at the 70 feet (Secaucus Fire) and 80 feet (Secaucus Police), as set forth on Exhibit A ("the Premises"), attached hereto and made a part hereof, upon the terms and conditions herein contained.

WHEREAS, the parties to this Agreement are a municipal entity of the State of New Jersey and an agency of the County of Hudson that are authorized to enter into agreements by and among themselves to jointly provide for the health, welfare and safety of its residents pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of each of the parties have independently concluded that the implementation of this Agreement for the shared services of an existing telecommunications tower on the property of HCST is in the best interests of all parties for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Secaucus, emergency responders, school district, and the general public.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. <u>Services to be Provided.</u> The Town of Secaucus shall construct at its own cost and expense a telecommunications platform on the existing telecommunications tower located on the HCST property and shall otherwise provide for accessory cabinets, conduits, pads and utilities to operate such municipal telecommunications service all for the public benefit as set forth on Exhibit B. The Town of Secaucus shall construct and build such platform pursuant to the standards established by the HCST developer, engineer and contractor and the specifications set forth on the attached Exhibits A and B.

2. Payments to the HCST: Other Terms and Conditions.

A. During the term of this Agreement, Secaucus shall be entirely responsible for the cost of the maintenance and repair of its platform, cabinets and equipment but shall make no payment to HCST for its use of the Tower. The parties acknowledge and agree that the Town of Secaucus was instrumental in its participation in investigating, supporting and assisting HCST in the development of the Tower site.

Furthermore, the operation of the telecommunications platform is inherently beneficial to the school district, the residents of the Town of Secaucus, emergency responders, and the general public. The right of Secaucus to use the tower is for the benefit of the Town of Secaucus alone and such right may not be assigned, sublet, alienated or hypothecated in any form or fashion without the express approval of HCST, which approval shall be in its sole and absolute discretion. However, approval shall not be unreasonably withheld. The Town of Secaucus acknowledges that the tower is used by other carriers and providers authorized by HCST and shall make certain that its operation at the tower in no way conflicts or impedes the operation of such other carriers and agrees that in the event that evidence is produced revealing the Town of Secaucus is impeding other carriers, it shall immediately after notice, cease-and-desist all operations until the conflict may be resolved. Furthermore, HCST acknowledges it is essential that the Town of Secaucus' use of the tower and communications not be interrupted or interfered with by other carriers or providers, therefore, Secaucus shall access property only through approved roadways and notify HCST of times it intends to visit the site. Secaucus will, through its engineers, contact and resolve any issues with the offending carrier; HCST will assist in any necessary action to enforce compliance. At all times during the operation of this Agreement, the Town of Secaucus shall carry insurance in sufficient amounts to insure against the loss or destruction of its equipment, cabinets and accessories. In addition, the Town of Secaucus shall carry workers compensation and general liability insurance in such amounts to protect against any and all claims for personal injury or property damage arising out of the operations of its employees, agents and subcontractors and such policies shall name HCST as an additional insured.

3. <u>Effective Date.</u>

This Agreement shall be effective upon the execution hereof, retroactive to January 1, 2022, after the adoption of appropriate resolutions by the governing bodies of HCST and the Town of Secaucus, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-1 et seq, as amended to the date hereof.

4. Term.

The term of this Agreement shall be for an initial period of five (5) years, renewable for four (4) additional five-year periods, unless either party notifies the other in writing at least six (6) months prior to expiration of the term of its intention not to renew. In the event the Town of Secaucus wishes to discontinue its use of the tower, HCST may insist that it remove its platform and all associated equipment at its sole cost and expense.

5. Modification, Waiver, and Construction.

- A. This Agreement shall not be modified unless the modification is in writing and is signed by authorized representatives of both parties.
- B. Written notice of the termination of the Agreement must be provided by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by courier to the Clerk of the municipality and HCST Board Secretary six (6) months prior to the termination.
- C. The failure of either party to require the performance of any term or obligation of this Agreement, or the waiver by either party of any breach of this Agreement, shall not prevent a subsequent enforcement of the term or obligation or be deemed a waiver of any subsequent breach.
- D. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

- E. Any cause of action, claim, suit, or civil action of any kind filed by either party arising out of or relating to the terms of this Agreement or the relationship of the parties shall be brought only in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Hudson County, New Jersey. Both parties irrevocably admit themselves to the jurisdiction of that Court.
- F. In the event any provision of this Agreement is determined to be unenforceable or contrary to law, the provision shall be struck but all other surviving provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.


