THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS, NEW JERSEY**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-5**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 28 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF  
SECAUCUS ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT" TO UPDATE COMPOSITION  
TO REFLECT DEPARTMENT NEEDS**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council, upon recommendation of the Police Chief, have determined that changes to the Ordinance entitled "Police Department" shall be made to account for the current personnel needs of the Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 28 entitled "Police Department," "§28-3. Composition of Department." of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows: (additions are indicated in **bold**, deletions indicated by ~~strikethroughs~~):

The Police Department of the Town of Secaucus shall consist of no more than:

- A. One Chief of Police;
- B. One Deputy Chief of Police;
- C. Three Captains;
- D. Ten Lieutenants;
- E. Fourteen Sergeants; and
- F. ~~Fifty~~ **Sixty**-five Police Officers.

The Chief of Police, Deputy Chief of Police, Captains, Lieutenants, Sergeants, and Police Officers shall be appointed to these positions by resolution of the Mayor and Council.

2. There are no other changes to this Chapter of the Code of the Town of Secaucus.
3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED** that the remainder of Chapter 28 of the Code of the Town of Secaucus shall remain in full force and effect.

THE TOWN OF SECAUCUS, NEW JERSEY**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-6**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 160A OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF  
SECAUCUS ENTITLED "HAIR SALONS, BARBERSHOPS, TANNING SALONS,  
BEAUTY PARLORS, TATTOO PARLORS, NAIL SALONS AND MASSAGE  
PARLORS" TO UPDATE PROVISIONS FOR LICENSING**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Secaucus has previously adopted an Ordinance licensing hair salons, barbershops, tanning salons, beauty parlors, tattoo parlors, nail salons and massage parlors in the interest of the safety, health and welfare of the public; and

**WHEREAS**, licensing is done annually for the various personal service businesses by the Board of Health pursuant to Chapter 160A of the Code of the Town of Secaucus; and

**WHEREAS**, upon the recommendation of the Department of Health and Police Department, the Mayor and Council have determined that an amendment to Chapter 160A to address the licensure of mobile and outcall massage and bodywork therapy services is warranted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Secaucus, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 160A entitled "Hair Salons, Barbershops, Tanning Salons, Beauty Parlors, Tattoo Parlors, Nail Salons and Massage Parlors" of the Code of the Town of Secaucus be, and is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows (additions are indicated in **bold**, deletions are marked by ~~crossouts~~):

§ 160A-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

**BODY ART**

Practice of physical body adornment in approved establishments by operators utilizing, but not limited to, body piercing, tattooing, or permanent cosmetics.

**COSMETOLOGY BUSINESS**

Shall encompass any person, firm or corporation that represents to the public that said person, firm or corporation is or are engaged in the occupation or business of shaving, trimming of facial hair; shampooing, cutting, arranging, dressing, curling, or any styling

of hair; applying cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics, lotions, creams, or makeup to scalp, face, or neck; massaging, cleansing, or stimulating face, neck, chest, or back only with or without cosmetic preparations; removing hair from face, neck, arms, legs or other areas by use of waxing, tweezing, or electrolysis; manicuring of nails or nail sculpting; pedicuring of toenails; and/or application or removal of semipermanent or permanent cosmetics on eyes, lips, or, eyebrows. "Cosmetology business" shall incorporate all persons, firms or corporations operating as, but not limited to, a nail salon, hair salon, barbershop, beauty parlor, spa, skin-care spa or specialty personal service spa.

## MASSAGE PARLORS

Any business offering the activity of structured touch which includes holding, applying pressure, positioning and mobilizing soft tissue of the body by manual technique and use of visual, kinesthetic, auditory and palpating skills to assess the body for purposes of applying therapeutic massage, body work or somatic principals, **which shall include the operation of all outcall and/or mobile massage and bodywork therapy services**. Such application may include the use of therapy such as heliotherapy or hydrotherapy, the use of moist hot and cold external applications, external application of herbal or topical preparations not classified as prescription drugs, explaining and describing miofascial movement, self-care and stress management as it relates to massage, body work and somatic therapies. Massage, body work and somatic therapy practices are designed to affect the energetic systems of the body for the purpose of promoting and maintaining the health and well being of the client. Massage, body work and somatic therapies will not include the diagnosis or treatment of illness, disease, impairment or disability.

...

### § 160A-3. Additional requirements for massage parlor licenses.

A. Conditions for issuance. In addition to the requirements of § 160A-2, a license to operate a massage parlor shall not be issued to any person, firm or corporation unless the following conditions are met:

- (1) Owners, corporate officers, partners, and/or limited-liability members submit a completed application as required by the chapter, along with proof of state licensure to own/operate a massage parlor.

...

B. Restrictions on location. No application for a new massage parlor establishment license shall be granted unless the establishment **and/or operation of massage and bodywork therapies are** is more than 1,000 feet away from any public or private educational institution (including day-care centers, elementary, high school and/or

college level) or house of worship.

2. The above reflects the full revisions to Chapter 160A. There are no other changes to this Chapter of the Code of the Town of Secaucus.
3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.
5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

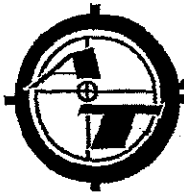

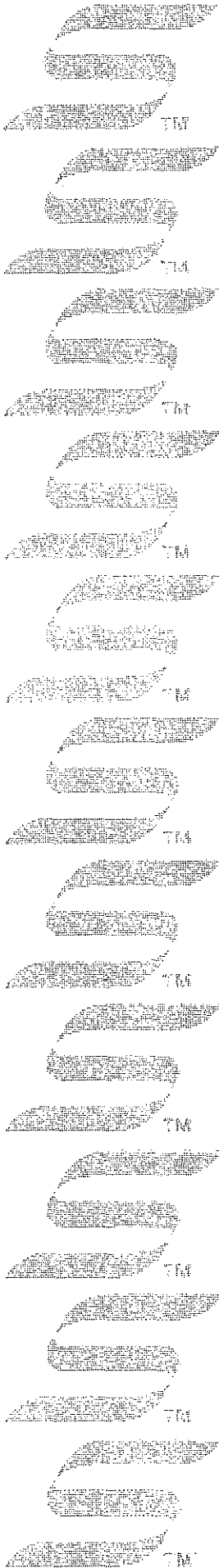

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While the proposed contract is inherently a time-and-materials engagement, based on prior experience with the Town and organizations of similar size, we contemplate that the Town will incur approximately 468 billable hours under the contract over the proposed year-long course of the contract (9 billable hours for each of 52 calendar weeks) for a total annual contemplated cost of \$74,880. **However, we stress again that because we are only fixing the hourly rate; actual costs will depend entirely upon the actual utilization of our services by the Town.**

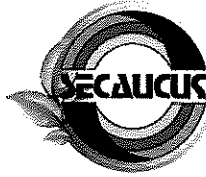

## Town of Secaucus Store Card and Procurement Card Policy

### PURPOSE

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 5:30-9A and Local Finance Notice 2018-13, the following policies and procedures shall govern the proper use of Store Cards and Procurement Cards, collectively referred to as “P-Card(s),” and establish the fiscal and managerial controls of such.

The Store Card and Procurement Card Policy (Policy) is established to document and define the methods and limitations of use for the US Bank Visa Purchasing Cards and Store Cards, which are provided to Town of Secaucus (Town) employees for purchases of business-related goods and services for the Town. The intent is to improve operational efficiencies for low dollar purchases, comply with Purchasing law, and reduce employee reimbursements.

### SCOPE

For the purpose of this Policy, “the Town” refers to the Town of Secaucus. All Town supervisors, department heads, employees, and any other individuals who may be granted P-Card privileges are subject to this Policy.

### DEFINITIONS

**Allowable Purchase** means a purchase of good(s) or service(s) that are needed for a legitimate business purpose and comply with the spending limits in this policy.

**Authorized Procurement Card User** means a Town employee authorized by the Town Administrator to make transactions using a P-Card and whose name or the “Town of Secaucus” physically appears on the P-Card.

**Designee** is an employee authorized by the Authorized Procurement Card User to use a P-Card in the absence of the Authorized Procurement Card User of the same Department.

**Preauthorized Vendor** means a supplier of goods or services that is authorized by the QPA or CFO/Finance Director.

**Procurement Card/Store Card (P-Card)** is a Town-issued credit card paid by the Town of Secaucus for Allowable Purchases.

**Procurement Cardholder (Cardholder)** is an employee of the Town who is granted P-Card privileges (including Authorized Procurement Card Users and designees) to use a P-Card for Allowable Purchases and trained/supervised in accordance with this Policy.

**Procurement Card Policy (P-Card Policy)** is a specific guideline applicable to P-Cards, as may be updated from time to time by the Town Attorney.

**Prohibited Purchase** is a purchase of good(s) or service(s) that is not an Allowable Purchase, including, but not limited to personal expense(s).

## **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

### Qualified Purchasing Agent (QPA) shall:

- Be the designated program manager for the Town.
- Be responsible for day-to-day oversight and management of supervisory review, including, but not limited to confirming the propriety and accuracy of P-Card usage.
- Organize training for each individual whose duties may at any time include the use of a procurement card, supervisory review or reconciliation of activity in the P-Card program, as well as the Town's policies and procedures concerning P-Card usage.
- Review, approve and update Cardholder information, including, but not limited to name change, phone change, limit modification or card cancellation/termination.
- Distribute P-Cards to authorized Cardholders, monitor card expiration dates, and issue replacement cards.
- Assist with resolving transactions that cannot be reconciled by the Cardholder.
- Review Cardholder activity and transactions to ensure the appropriateness of purchases on the P-Card and report any activity that does not comply with this policy to the Cardholder, CFO, and Town Administrator.
- Review vendor activity for compliance with general procurement policies and procedures.
- Maintain a list of preauthorized vendors for Cardholders to refer to when utilizing the P-Card.

### Chief Financial Officer (CFO)/Finance Director shall:

- Be responsible for supervising the program manager's oversight of the local unit's P-Card program.
- Review expense reports and conduct reconciliation of activity.
- Processes payment to the Designated Financial Institution.
- Ensure budgeted funds are available prior to incurring charges on the Purchasing Card.
- Reevaluate Program on an as needed basis, but not less frequently than annually.
- Review monthly statements and conduct an audit of P-Card transactions.

### Cardholder shall:

- Write on the invoices, receipts and/or supporting documentation who purchased the good(s) and/or service(s).
- Submit invoices, receipts and supporting documentation to the QPA and/or CFO/Finance Director within two (2) business days of the date of purchase.
- Complete returns of good(s) and service(s) in a timely manner and ensure the Town receives credit or is not billed. Receipts or invoices for returns shall be provided to the QPA and/or Finance Department within two (2) business days of the date of purchase.
- Obtain preauthorization of vendors from the QPA or CFO/Finance Director.
- Maintain the security of the P-Card, including:
  - Safeguarding the P-Card from theft and loss;

- Not allowing the use of the P-Card by parties other than the Cardholder and/or his/her designees;
- Immediately notifying the card provider first, and then the QPA and CFO immediately thereafter, if the P-Card is stolen, lost, or if fraudulent activity is believed to have occurred;
- Notifying the QPA of any updates to Cardholder information, including, but not limited to name change, phone change, limit modification or card cancellation/termination.
- Obtain detailed receipts for P-Card purchases. Detailed receipts, at a minimum, must include:
  - The date of transaction;
  - Time of transaction;
  - The description and quantity of good(s) and/or service(s) purchased;
  - Price of good(s) and/or service(s) purchased;
  - Delivery address, if applicable;
  - Vendor's name; and
  - The location of the vendor.
- Notify the vendor that the purchase is exempt from New Jersey State sales tax, use tax and Federal excise tax. Provide the vendor with the Town's New Jersey State Tax Exempt Number. If a Cardholder is charged tax on a purchased item, the Cardholder shall make every effort to obtain credit from the vendor for the imposed tax.
- Shall complete a monthly expense log, attached hereto as Appendix B, with the following details, to be maintained/recorded by the Head of the Department, and available to be produced upon request:
  - The date of transaction;
  - Card being used (i.e., Home Depot Store Card, John Doe's P-Card);
  - Vendor's name;
  - The description and quantity of good(s) and/or service(s) purchased;
  - Total price of good(s) and/or service(s) purchased; and
  - The Cardholder/Designee who completed the purchase.

## **AUTHORIZATION**

The Town Administrator shall designate a person who is authorized to use a P-Card for departmental purchases of goods and services. All authorized P-Card users and his/her designees must comply with the P-Card policies outlined herein and with Local Public Contract Laws. In the absence of the Authorized Procurement Card User of the Department, the Authorized Procurement Card User may authorize a designee to use a P-Card. The designee shall have the same responsibilities as an Authorized Procurement Card User.

Upon separation of employment with the Town of Secaucus via termination, resignation, or retirement, authorized procurement card users must immediately submit the procurement card to the QPA or the CFO/Finance Director.

## **PROCEDURE**

### Appropriate Use of P-Cards

All authorized P-Card users shall complete and sign a contract of understanding, attached hereto as Appendix A, that includes financial responsibility for misuse of the P-Card. A card shall not be issued unless it can be shown that such issuance is necessary for the conduct of ongoing operations in the normal course of providing government services. All authorized P-Card users are only able to charge P-cards for tangible supplies or non-tangible items under the following conditions:

1. When payment to vendors is required in advance of the delivery of certain materials or services that cannot be obtained from any other source at comparable prices.
  - a. An individual transaction shall not exceed 15% of the local unit's bid threshold, unless approved by the Town's QPA;
  - b. Comparable pricing is not otherwise obtainable for such goods or services to be available at the time and place required; and
  - c. The QPA or CFO/Finance Director has approved such item for purchase from a particular vendor.
  - d. Examples include, but are not limited to, purchases from stores that do not accept vouchers, subscriptions, or conference registrations, with each transaction limited to 15% of the local unit's bid threshold, unless approved by the QPA.
2. When ordering, billing and payment transactions for goods and services are made through a computerized electronic transaction (i.e. on the Internet), as authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:5-16.
  - a. An individual transaction shall not exceed 15% of the local unit's bid threshold, unless approved by the Town's QPA;
  - b. When an order is placed from a computer to a computer, such as on the Internet or similar computer network;
  - c. The vendor requires immediate payment; and
  - d. The QPA or CFO/Finance Director has approved such item for purchase from a particular vendor.
  - e. Examples include, but are not limited to, online purchases for books, conference registrations, and office supplies, with each transaction limited to 15% of the local unit's bid threshold, unless approved by the QPA.

#### Spending Limits

All purchases of goods and services using a P-Card must be done in compliance with the Local Public Contracts Law; use of a P-Card does not change or eliminate any provisions of that law. Individual P-Card purchases shall be for any other tangible supply, part or material necessary for the ongoing operation and function of the Town, pre-authorized by the QPA or CFO/Finance Director, but in no case shall any individual transaction exceed 15% of the Town's bid threshold.

#### Reconciliation

All P-Card transactions must be reconciled monthly by the Cardholder with the invoice, order confirmation, receipt, or supporting purchase documentation. Invoices, order confirmations, receipts, or supporting purchase documentation are to be submitted by the Cardholder to the QPA or CFO/Finance Director within two (2) business days. All P-Card transactions and accompanying reconciling documents must be reviewed and approved by the QPA or CFO/Finance Director monthly.

Any item appearing on the statement of activity for which no receipt has been presented, or any disparity in amounts between original receipts and charges appearing on the statement of activity shall be verified by the Cardholder or otherwise contested by the QPA or CFO/Finance Director.

#### Violations

Use of the P-card to purchase any product or service must comply with those permitted by the Town's Procurement Policies and comply with Local Public Contract Laws. **Under no circumstance shall P-Cards be utilized for personal use. P-Cards shall not be used for travel and dining expenses for government employees, volunteers, or officials. Cash advances from P-Cards is strictly prohibited.** Any unauthorized or inappropriate use of a P-Card will result in cancellation of the P-Card and will subject the Cardholder or his/her designee to disciplinary action including, but not limited to, reimbursement of expenses, termination of employment and criminal prosecution.

#### **LOST, MISPLACED OR STOLEN PROCUREMENT CARDS**

Cardholders are required to immediately report any lost or stolen P-Card to the Card Issuer at the phone number provided on the P-Card. The Cardholder must also immediately notify the QPA and CFO/Finance Director about the lost or stolen card. The notification should include the date the Cardholder first discovered the card missing and the circumstances of the theft, loss or misappropriation. In the event the Cardholder has not notified the Card Issuer, the QPA or CFO/Finance Director shall terminate the card immediately.
